SPLIT SECOND (195 x 30 Min) A fast-paced network hit quiz show where contestants are rewarded not only for their ability to answer correctly, but on how many others are also correct on questions in the that same category. ABC Network hit from 1972 to 1975, hosted by Tom Kennedy (130 x Half Hour). Updated version syndicated in 1986 hosted by Monty Hall (65 x Half Hour).



NEW BATTLESTARS (65 x 30 Min) A spin-off of the famed show "Hollywood Squares" this game show features six celebrities who are seated in triangles and answer game questions for the contestant. The object of the game is to capture three celebrities by putting out the lights around him or her. Celebrities include Linda Blair, Fannie Flagg, Telma Hopkins, Rip Taylor, Tom Poston. "Battlestars" ran in 1980-1983. Both are hosted both by Alex Trebek.



ALL-STAR BLITZ (195 x 30 Min) Another updated version of the "Hollywood Squares" multi-celebrity game. Two contestants, one usually a returning champion, competed to uncover and solve hidden word puzzles with the help of a four celebrity panel. Celebrity cast includes: Barbara Eden, Charles Nelson Reilly, Tom Poston, Dennis Weaver, Rose Marie, Jamie Farr, Leslie Uggams, Priscilla Barnes, Harvey Korman, Dick Butkus & others. ABC Network series hosted by Peter Marshall and each episode feature four celebrities.
